

La Prairie site Regulation

- 1- Every pilot has to have wings, be in order with the MAAC, and post his Brossair membership card.
- 2- All the safety regulations of the MAAC and the club Brossair will be applied to the site.
- 3- Any flight has to be made accompanied with a co-pilot who also detains his wings.
- 4- No flights can be made without the presence of at least one Brossair Float Flight committee member. (A minimum of 3 members are required at any time: a committee member, the pilot and his co-pilot)
- 5- The flights are authorized from Monday to Friday inclusively. Absolute ban to fly over the week-ends and during the official holidays; after the sunset as well: exception to fewer events authorized by the club Brossair.
- 6 Any time, a safe distance must be maintained between the plane, the shore, the boats and the peoples presents on the site as well. The priority will be left to the maritime navigation and the pleasure crafts.
- 7- Every pilot who will want to fly from the site, will have to have a boat available.
- 8- No alcohol or drugs will be tolerated.
